*\*The national competition committee reserves the right to combine single age groups together in levels where less than 10 athletes are entered.*

**AGE DETERMINATION:** Determined by the athlete's age at the time of the AAU National Championship's first day of competition (July 30, 2008). Athletes MUST compete at their AAU District Championship in the age division in which they will be at the AAU National Championships. You must be 3 years of age by July 30, 2008 to compete.

**QUALIFICATION:** Competitors must have competed in an AAU District Championship and/or their club must have competed at least five (5) athletes in one AAU Invitational prior to the AAU District Championships. A competitor can compete in only one level/one age group in trampoline and only one level/one age group in tumbling. You must submit a petition to the National Chair if you can not attend the District Championship.

**AAU MEMBERSHIP:** All athletes and coaches must be members of their AAU District. AAU membership is \$12.00 per youth athlete and \$14.00 per coach (non-athlete). Join on-line at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org).

**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED ONLINE at [www.aaujrogames.org](http://www.aaujrogames.org).**

Entries must be completed online by **Friday, June 20, 2008**. Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover is accepted. You will need to have your AAU membership at the time of registering. After registering online, you will receive an email confirming your entry and acceptance of payment.

Any late entries that are accepted will not count for District awards. Entries received after the deadline of June 20 must include a \$50 late fee per athlete entered. This is in addition to the entry fee. To enter an event the day of competition, a double entry fee will be charged.

It is the responsibility of the parent, coach, instructor, and athlete to ensure that the application is in on time and complete in every detail.

**\*\* Awards will stop one hour before the Parade of Champions.**

**WORKOUT RULES  
AND DRESS CODE:**

Wear foot covering for TR/DBL – athletes must wear competition attire.

**COACHES:** During workouts and competition, the following dress code must be followed:

1. Track suit, team t-shirt, or polo shirt, pants or finger length hemmed shorts. **NO HALTER TOPS OR TOPS WHERE STOMACH SHOWS.**
2. **Must wear athletic shoes.**
3. **No denim pants or shorts allowed.**
4. **Violators will be asked to leave the floor.**

**PROTESTS:**

A \$50 protest fee must accompany any protest. If you win the protest, the fee will be returned to you.

**CHANGE FEE:**

After the Coaches Report is sent out, there will be a \$25.00 fee associated with any changes. Check should be made payable to *AAU Trampoline and Tumbling*.
